About Carl Morrison

Carl Morrison, long-time friend of the water community, died when his plane went down in a storm over Petaluma as he was flying home from the 2018 North Bay Watershed Association conference.

Carl was a family man, man of faith, Marine veteran, and Vice Commander of California's Civil Air Patrol. He loved flying and shared that love with others. Carl was active in many important projects and supported a number of water efforts including, his work in helping manage the Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management region, support of the climate efforts in the Resilient by Design and his management work as part of the Bay Area Flood Protection Agencies Association.

One of Carl's greatest achievements was the assistance he provided in developing the Advanced Quantitative Precipitation Information (AQPI) which will greatly improve storm forecasting and water supply decision across the region. Carl lead the Bay Area Integrated Regional Water Management region's grant application for the project and had been supporting its implementation. Carl is remembered as a good friend to many of us in the North Bay water community.
