WHEREAS, the Association is committed to sound management of its financial resources; and

WHEREAS, the Association annually adopts a balanced budget, but cannot always predict future costs and expenditures; and

WHEREAS, maintaining a targeted Operating Cash Reserve will make the Association more financially resilient and better able to weather future economic uncertainties;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the North Bay Watershed Association, as follows:

- 1. All recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The Association hereby adopts the Financial Reserve Policy, which is attached hereto as Attachment 1 and is incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The Association hereby adopts the Policy as set forth in Attachment A hereto.
